A. Sochi was named by the members of the International Olympic Committee as the capital of the Winter Olympic Games in 2014. They carefully studied the potential of six other cities. At first there was no clear winner between three candidates: Austria, Korea and Russia. The final decision took place on July, 4th, 2007 when Sochi received the greatest number of votes.

B. The history of the Olympic Games began in ancient Greece more than 2700 years ago. Athletes gathered in Olympia for a great festival and they competed in running, boxing, discus throwing and other sports popular at that time. The public celebrated the winners like war heroes. Nevertheless, the Games were stopped in 394 by a Roman emperor.

C. Thousands of people from all over the country want to take part in the event and make the Games enjoyable for athletes and fans. They are going to work for free but the number of candidates still exceeds the number of jobs. The requirements for candidates are very basic: they should be friendly, helpful and should know a foreign language. They also have to take a special training course in one of the Olympic centers.

D. Many countries in Europe supported the idea of peaceful sports competitions. Finally, in the 19th century Baron Pierre de Coubertin from France offered to restart the Olympic Games. He believed that the competitions could develop the spirit of the nation and promote sports among people – where ever possible. Since then the Olympic Games have been held once every four years, each time in a different country.

E. Sochi is situated in Krasnodar, the third largest region in Russia. The Games will be held in two clusters. Ice events will take place near the coast while other events will be in the Krasnaya Polyana Mountains. The trip from one cluster to another takes around 30 minutes. The Olympic Park and Olympic Village have new stadiums, modern sports and press centers and comfortable hotels.
